Requirements and Qualifications:

- Advanced training in CBT and/or Clinical Hypnosis.
- Ability to work ~ 35 hours a week, including 22 clinical hours with at least 6 hours of late afternoon, evening, and/or weekend availability.
- Interest in developing an expertise in a growing health psychology sub-field (psychogastroenterology) and routinely collaborating with providers from various disciplines.
- Interest in on-going clinical consultation, training, and use of empirically supported treatments.
- Skills and knowledge to facilitate telehealth via a video platform. The position is being advertised as completely remote.

Full Job Description:

GI Psychology is expanding our team of mental health professionals dedicated to providing effective and individualized behavioral health care for complex medical conditions. Our team consists of highly skilled Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT) and Acceptance & Commitment Therapy (ACT) clinicians that receive internal and external specialty training in facilitating relief for GI disorders and other medical conditions. We value collaboration, ongoing personal development, and serving local and national communities. Our practice offers a collegial,



supportive environment with a steady flow of referrals from physical health providers, GI specialists, and other mental health providers.

This is a unique opportunity to join a thriving self-pay psychotherapy practice as a **W2** employee, with the flexibility to establish your own work schedule. Although we are based in Northern Virginia, we have team members in numerous states. Fully qualified clinicians will earn \$105/hour plus up to \$12,000/year in bonuses. Hourly pay range is \$85-105/hour, commensurate with experience. This position includes the following **benefits**: continuing education reimbursement, advanced health psychology and clinical hypnosis training, team consultation, and liberal time-off policies. The Practice is also in the process of adding additional benefits such as health care, dental, and vision and/or retirement matching, depending on interest.

We are looking for a reliable and organized clinician who has interpersonal strengths that facilitate client rapport building and effective teams. A good fit would be a clinician who has (1) strong experience using CBT, (2) knowledge of the intersection between psychological and physical health, (3) excellent written and oral communication, and (4) is eager to learn and engage in professional development. Clinicians interested in opportunities for leadership and program development are especially encouraged to apply.

Responsibilities include:

- Providing individual psychotherapy to children, adolescents, and adults; there is the opportunity for group services if interested
- Becoming fully trained in research-supported treatments for GI disorders and chronic pain
- Participate in weekly paid supervision, consultation meetings, and internal paid training
- Utilize Simple Practice (EHR) to maintain timely record keeping; you are *not* responsible for collecting direct payments
- Attend bi-weekly staff meeting with Practice Director
- Regularly collaborate with external health providers for the purposes of care coordination
- Provide community education on gastropsych through Practice outreach projects (i.e. blogs, flyers, conferences, lunch & learns, etc.)



The practice will provide:

- Supportive organizational culture that aims to inspire the pursuit of individual professional development goals
- Opportunities to help advance patient access to effective treatments for GI distress
- Marketing and referral stream; most new patients are referred to us from established health providers
- Malpractice insurance coverage
- Paid admin time for community education, training, supervision, consultation, and meetings
- Administrative support, including initial patient screenings, scheduling of clients, initiating paperwork, and billing processes.

- Payroll administration. Clinicians will be considered an employee and will be paid every other week. Practice will pay all payroll associated taxes and will administer a W2 at the end of each year. This is different from most private practices, where clinicians are considered independent contractors and must pay quarterly estimated tax payments.
